Dear Mayor Fawcett and members of Council:

The following questions are submitted for the Public Question Period to be held during the Council meeting on January 21, 2010:

1. Council indicated on December 17<sup>th</sup> that it would order and make available a revised workplan for the development of the new Official Plan as the existing workplan was considerably out of date. Council also indicated that it would provide for public consultation before submitting the draft plan to the province for review. Could Council please indicate the status of the promised and revised workplan?
2. Council indicated on January 7<sup>th</sup> that it would develop a budget process schedule, including provision for public consultation, at the January 12<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Committee of the Whole. Council also indicated that it would post that schedule following the meeting. Could Council please indicate the status of the promised budget process schedule?
3. Council indicated on January 7<sup>th</sup> that it would check on the location of, and the identity of the landowners participating in, the 3,500 acre wind farm announced in November by 401 Energy. Could Council please indicate what steps have been taken since that time and report what it has learned?
4. Council indicated in Committee of the Whole on January 12<sup>th</sup> that the initial PSAB report estimate of road and infrastructure replacement costs was approximately \$26 million, quite apart from ongoing maintenance and repair costs. Could Council please confirm that it will begin allocating monies toward that end, indicate the amount to be allocated in the 2010 budget, and identify where that money will come from?
