



Commissioner for Taking Oaths

The Township of Melancthon has two signing officers (by virtue of their office) who have authority to Commission documents requiring a “Commissioner of Oaths”. This service is provided to residents of Melancthon Township only and is subject to availability of a Commissioner of Oaths. **Residents are recommended to call ahead and make an appointment.** There is no fee for this service.

You will be required to present one original piece of original government-issued photo identification (no copies permitted) i.e. valid driver’s licence.

Commissioners **will not** sign:

- Wills, Living Wills, Codicils to Wills
- Powers of Attorney
- Divorce, Separation, Cohabitation, Custody Documents
- Court Documents or Documents related to a court proceeding
- Theft related Documents
- Real Estate Documents
- Documents noting a signature of a Notary Public
- Age of Majority or BYID card application

Please be advised that the Commissioner will first review the document to determine if the document meets their specification.

NOTE: The Commissioner of Oaths reserves the right to refuse commissioning services of any document.
