## Notice of Motion from last meeting regarding gas tax for transit

Deferred to the next meeting of Council as Deputy Mayor White (who moved the motion at the January 23, 2014 meeting) was absent.

#### **Applications to Permit**

The CAO presented an application from Eli Sherk/Isaac Martin to permit a 50' x 105' machine shop with attached 19' x 20' office and 12' x 32' power room on Part of Lot 26, Concession 7 NE. Discussion ensued because the size of the machine shop was larger than what was permitted under the On Farm Uses By-law. A five minute break was taken at 9:55 a.m. so that the CAO could go and get the rezoning file.

When the CAO returned, she advised that the property was rezoned in 2010 to permit the machine shop and limitations placed on the size of the machine shop at 6,028 square feet. The matter was deferred to the next meeting and the CAO was asked to send the applications to Jerry Jorden, Township Planner for his comment on conformity. The Mayor and CAO will have a discussion with the Planner next Tuesday to see if the Zoning By-law Amendment can be amended to conform to the On Farm Uses By-law or perhaps we can ask the applicant for voluntary compliance.

# **New/Other Business**

### **ODRAP Resolution**

Moved by Malek, Seconded by Crowe that Whereas the Township of Melancthon recently experienced a severe winter storm from January 24<sup>th</sup> until February 1<sup>st</sup> 2014; and, Whereas the Township has experienced substantial costs and disruption of infrastructure which will have a long term financial impact; and, Whereas other municipalities in the County of Dufferin similarly experienced the effects of the severe winter storm on municipal property and infrastructure; Now therefore be it resolved: 1) That Melancthon Township Council request the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing ("MMAH") to declare the Township of Melancthon a "disaster area" for the purposes of the Ontario Disaster Relief Assistance Program (ODRAP); and, 2) That Staff be authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to this resolution. Carried.

#### **Unfinished Business**

Councillor Malek advised that the Fire Chief has gone over the recommendations and the Department is sitting in a good place. The goal is to have this done by April 1<sup>st</sup>. Melancthon needs to get its Simplified Risk Assessment updated, as well as an Establishing and Regulating By-law. The CAO will put this on the next Agenda. As

Councillor Malek is a member of the Shelburne Fire Board she has asked the Shelbu Fire Chief for an update.

The CAO was directed to have a Representative from Cornerstone Standards Council come to the next meeting of Council so the members can get more information on this. The road accounts were presented in the amount of \$327,208.96. Moved by Crowe, Seconded by Malek that the road accounts be approved as presented by the Acting Road Superintendent. Carried.

## <u>Unfinished Business - Southgate-Melancthon Townline - Invoice for survey</u>

The CAO advised of the resolution that was passed on November 21, 2013. Council is unsure as to why a survey was required and there was no approval by Council to do a survey. Consensus of Council to just let this be and not pay the invoice.

#### 2014 Draft Operating and Capital Budget

The Treasurer, Wendy Atkinson, presented another draft of the budget and explained the changes that were made to it. The draft budget as presented represents at 2.9% increase in the tax rate. Craig Micks, Acting Road Superintendent raised concerns about the cost of snow removal due to the storm and it was advised to leave this out as we would be applying to the Province for some assistance under the ODRAP. As this was advertised as a public meeting, there was one member of the public in attendance and he was given a copy of the budget and he inquired about revenue from the Dufferin Wind Project. It was explained that the Township would not see any revenue until the turbines have been in commercial operation for one year. Wendy advised that she would have the actuals listed for the next meeting and consensus of Council is that they were ready to pass this draft budget. The public will be given another opportunity at the next meeting for comments and the budget to be posted on the website.
