## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this report is to update Council on Public Works activities for September 21 - October 12, 2018.

### **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

The following activities were undertaken for the period of September 21 - October 12, 2018:

<u>High Street - Horning's Mills</u> - finished the retaining wall and sodded.

<u>Manitoba Street and Argyle Street In Corbetton</u> - streets finished – possibly need one more load of gravel.

<u>Ditching</u> - Ditching was completed on 15 Sideroad at Horning's Mills and 240 Sideroad at 6<sup>th</sup> Line NE West to the box culvert – little more to do here.

<u>Trees</u> - Tree was blown down on hydro lines on William Street in Horning's Mills and Staff cleaned it up. Hedge cleaned up on Argyle Street, Corbetton.

<u>Shop</u> - maintenance on equipment, general repairs and clean up.

Roads - grading, cold patching, hauling gravel to some no winter maintenance roads.
Horning's Mills Park - fixing gates and removed tree fort.
<u>Municipal Office Parking Lot in front of new PW building</u> - finished yard – hauling fill out and gravel in.
Winter Sand - over the course of a week, the sand dome was filled with this year's winter sand.
Garbage - picking up garbage
