The Legion is planning on applying for an FCC AgriSpirit Fund grant, which closes on March 29. The grant is for capital projects in rural municipalities with populations of less than 150,000 for capital projects. The legion would like to apply for the maximum of \$25,000.00 to replace two furnaces and install two air conditioners.

One of the conditions of the grant is that a municipal partner be sought.

This is from the Agrispirit website:

What is the role of a municipal partner and why do I need one?

There is no national registration for non-profit organizations so they must partner with their local municipal body to qualify for funding. If you're selected for funding, the cheque will be made payable to the municipal body, care of your project. You'll need to work with the municipal body to get the funds. If you're chosen for funding, your partnering municipal body must also sign a contract to show that they support your project.

There would be no financial obligation on the part of the Township, really just a bank account and a signature on the contract showing support.

We are hoping that the Township of Melancthon would be willing to be our municipal partner.
