Hi Denise and Craig,

Now that we have secured the GRCA Permit for the Bridge 13 Rehabilitation work, I expect we will be able to get the project out to tender in November 2020. I'll be in touch shortly with some proposed dates once we finalize the tender.

However, we expect to have the results of the concrete core sampling and testing from Bridge 11 next week. Once we have reviewed the results, I'll let the Township know if it makes more sense to tender Bridge 11 & 13 as one project (therefore tender early in 2021, construction later in 2021), or hold off on work on Bridge 11 until a later date.

Craig, I'll give you a call today or tomorrow, as I would like to meet with you on site next week at Bridge 13 in Riverview to discuss the scope of work further, specifically guide rail.
